El rock mexicano María del Carmen de la Peza Casares, 2014-01-30 María del Carmen de la Peza concibe el rock como un fenómeno sociocultural y político complejo, en el que participan actores y espectadores en el espacio público mediante la acción y el discurso. En este sentido, el rock constituye un espacio fértil para explorar la emergencia de los roqueros como sujetos políticos y las relaciones conflictivas de los sujetos —de clase, raza, género y generación— entre sí y con los poderes constituidos.
