Editors Arlyn and Matthew J. Bruccoli have employed the same methods to reestablish this text as they used to wide acclaim in their centennial edition of O Lost: The Story of a Buried Life, the unabridged version of Wolfe's Look Homeward, Angel. The reestablishment of the long version of Four Lost Men opens an undeveloped area of scholarship into Wolfe's short fiction and serves as a model for restoring other such works.
